From 93/128 South to Rte. 3 South. Take Exit 9 and bear right onto Rte. 3A (Main Street). At the second set of lights, take a left onto Rte. 80 (Brook Street). Drive approximately 1/4 mile and our entrance is on the left. As you come up the hill the Country Club is directly ahead and tournament parking is on the right.

From Points South

Take Rte. 3 North. Take Exit 9 and bear right onto Rte. 3A (Main Street). Follow the directions for Points North.

Mike's story



Michael McKenna is an adorable seven year -old boy. He loves his family, Thomas the Tank Engine videos, taking long car rides and swimming. Michael also has autism. At a very young age, his parents noticed that he was different from other children. He didn't have play skills, could not talk, had poor eye contact, involuntary movements and vocalization and didn't interact with other children. By age five, his disabilities became so profound, even the most well intentioned teachers and therapists simply gave up.

At the advice of an educational consultant, Michael's parents were encouraged to take a tour of The New England Center for Children (NECC®) in Southborough, MA. Now age seven, Michael is making gains previously thought impossible. With NECC, Michael is maximizing his own independence and individual potential. Michael's story is indicative of the hope NECC gives kids with autism and their parents.
